### Where and when

Bottisham Village College, Tuesdays, 19.15 – 21.15 , from 21<sup>st</sup> September 2010 for 10 weeks.

### Details

This class is designed for students who want to learn the basics of sewing. It will give you the opportunity to learn how to use a sewing machine in a friendly and supportive class. For those already with a machine, you are welcome to bring in your own. Projects include cushions and bags, through to following simple dressmaking patterns to create your own clothes.

Perhaps bring along a range of remnants and materials to recycle and create something unique, or you may like to have a go at your own project.

Although the class is aimed at total beginners, with lots of practical guidance, all abilities are welcome.

### Materials required

Please bring suitable fabrics and a sewing kit containing scissors, pins, needles, thread, tape measure and chalk, although some equipment is available for your use. A notebook and pen may also be helpful.
